Taking this as a guide to direct the efforts of the AFG, we are pleased to announce we have secured the services of Fr. Hughes SJ from Oxford. Fr Hughes taught Philosophy at Heythorpe College, University of London from 1970 until 1998, and then was Master of Campion Hall, the Jesuit College in the University of Oxford, until his term of office expired in 2006. He tutors in the university, and has recently written books on the problem of evil, and on religious fundamentalism. It is proposed Fr. Hughes will deliver a talk entitled:

### **What is it all about?**

*Does the universe have a point? A meaning? Does thinking of God as Creator really explain anything? Is God present in our lives?*

*We have all asked questions like these. Fr Gerry J Hughes SJ will explore some answers in the light of contemporary science, philosophy and our own experience.*

This promises to be a most enlightening, stimulating and thought provoking talk and discussion, helping participants to better understand and develop their faith. Further details will follow, but please in the meantime keep Saturday 28th May from 2-00pm / 5-00pm free.
